- Use clean and renewable energy
- Reduce fossil oils to achieve the carbon neutrality
- Protect and promote biodiversity (local consumption, reforestation)
- Guarantee access to drinkable water in the whole planet

Indicators of the LSG 1

- Quantity of disposable water in a geographic region
- Quantity or quality of natural resources
- Capacity of reuse of a resource without compromising its quality or existence
- Number and type of biological species in a zone
- Concentration of contaminants in the tissues of the organisms
- Condition of the atmosphere ozone
- Level of subterranean water
- Quantity of water used per day
- Quantity of water used per unity of production
- Concentration of specific contaminants in the air, water or land
- Longevity of human being in a specific territory
- Density of population
- Born rate
- Studies about epidemics
- Resources invested in reducing consumption of scarce natural resources.
- Decrease in resource consumption in relation to investment made.
- Degree of substitution of fossil fuel energy by renewable and clean energy.
- Degree of adaptation of the energy used according to the climate of the area: photovoltaic, geothermal, aérothermal, etc.
- Form of transport and distance of distribution of natural resources (preference of local consumption).
- Percentage of privatization of natural resources and their management.
